We would be honored to have your company or community organization represented in the parade as we celebrate American Independence Day on the Fourth of July. A day that represents the Declaration of Independence and the birth of the United States of America as an independent nation.

Beginning at 8:30 a.m., vehicle entries will assemble in the south parking lot of the Finney County Fairgrounds. Flag units, bands and marching entries should gather at the American Legion Parking lot. Please arrive by 9:30 a.m. so the parade can begin promptly at 10:00 a.m.

The parade route will start on South Main Street, near the former National Guard Armory [now home to the American Legion], move North on Main [for safety do not stop on the railroad tracks] Walnut Street. The Garden City Police Department would prefer everyone to turn Left [West] onto Walnut Street and go to Eight Street turn Left [South] onto Eight Street to Fulton Street turn Right [West] to Ninth Street turn Left [South] to the Finney County Fairground South Parking Lot.

All entries must have at least one American Flag of any size attached to entry.

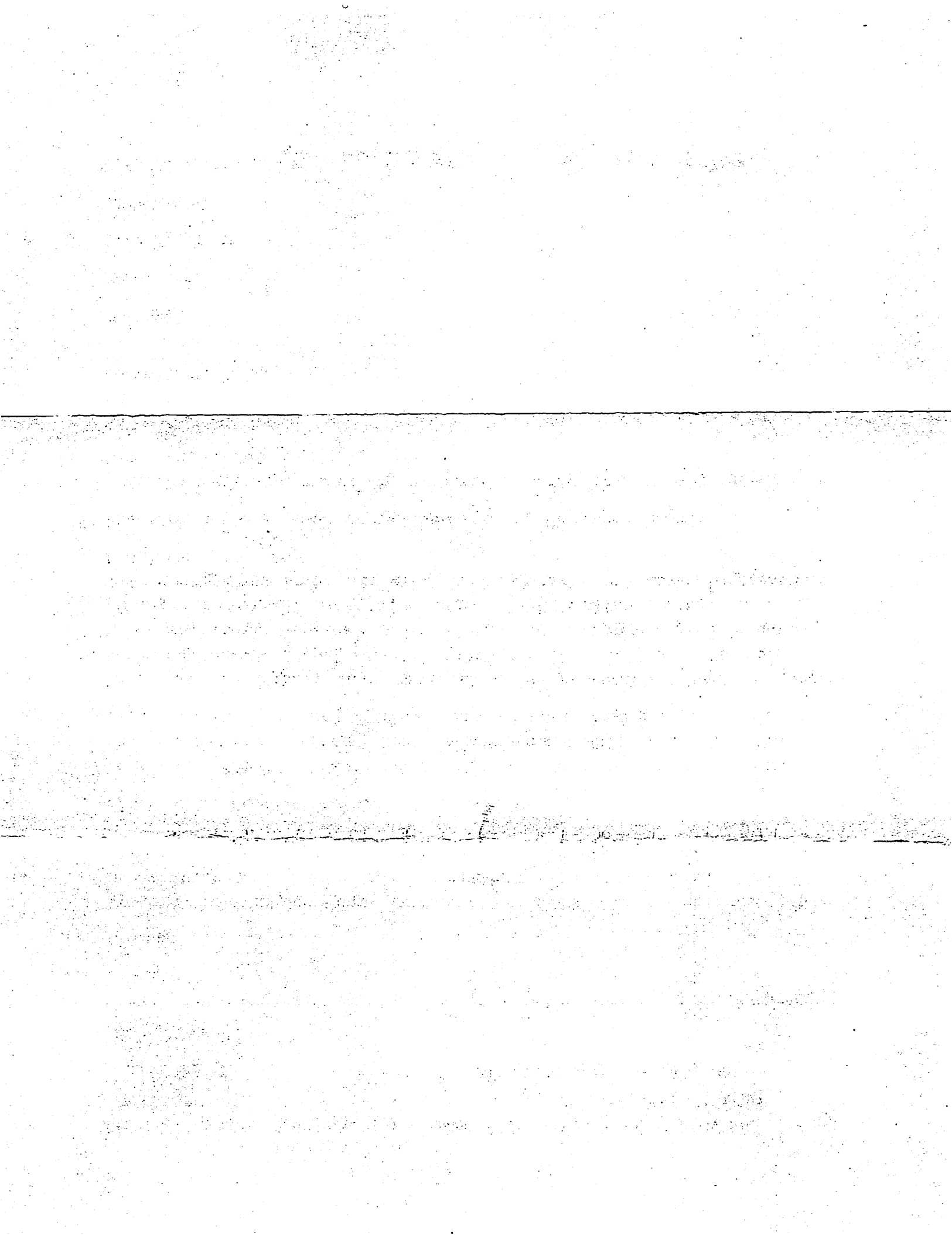

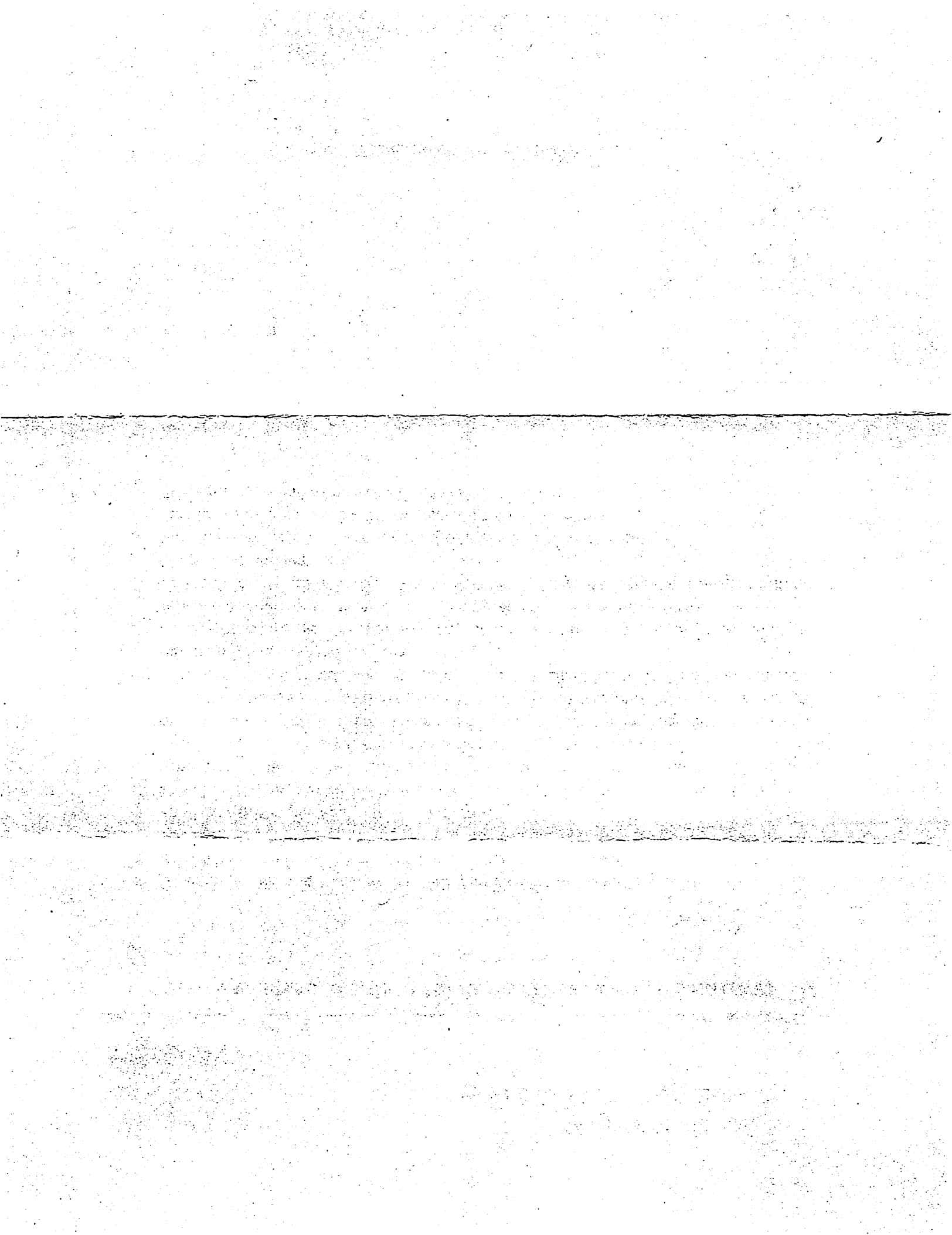

VETS FOR VETERANS CLUB, INC. 4TH OF JULY PARADE RULES REGARDING ENTRIES

- No animals will be allowed in the parade due to fireworks and issues thereof.
- It shall be unlawful unless directed by a police officer, for a driver of a vehicle to drive between the vehicles or persons comprising the parade when the parade is in motion and is conspicuously designated as a parade.
- The Chief of Police or his designee may refuse to allow a particular float, vehicle, or other unit to participate in the parade if any such float, vehicle or other unit is deemed unsafe. Floats, vehicles, and/or other units of the parade must be safe in both vehicular mobility and any attachments placed upon them. Persons riding such floats, vehicle or other units must be in positions where they cannot be accidentally thrown or dislodged.
- There shall be no parade walkers under the age of 10. Children under 10 years must be riding on floats, vehicles, or other units.
- Candy, prizes, novelty items or any other items shall not be thrown or given out from a vehicle, stopped, or moving, while in the parade or procession. However, it is permissible for parade participants to walk along the route and hand candy or other items to parade watchers.
- Must have at least one American flag of any size attached to entry.
- Vets for Veterans Club, Inc. is not responsible for accidents.
- No new entries will be allowed the day of the parade.
